Knowledge, Skills and Abilities

- Drive fire apparatus and/or operate fire apparatus on emergency call or at incident scene.
- Operation of fire apparatus, equipment, tools, devices and their proper use.
- Responds to emergency and non-emergency incidents including Hazardous Materials.
- Participate in cleaning and maintaining facilities, grounds, equipment and apparatus.
- Must comply with department rules and regulations according to the SOG.
- Understand and follow oral and written directions promptly and accurately.
- Study street and occupancy locations in assigned district.

- Inspects equipment and apparatus and notifies supervisor of any defects, in addition to keeping clear and precise records.
- Participates in training activities and instruction sessions.
- Maintain physical condition to perform essential duties as specified by firefighter certification.
- Performs all work duties and activities in accordance with the Department's policies and Procedures.
- Works in a safe manner and reports unsafe activity and conditions.
- Maintain mental capacity which allows the capability of:
Exercising sound judgment and rational thinking under dangerous circumstances;
Evaluating various options and alternatives and choose an appropriate and reasonable course of action; and
Demonstrating intellectual capabilities during training and testing processes.
- Perform other related job duties and tasks as assigned by your supervisor.
